Often times, though, classic Chinese literature can be tough to get into for those not familiar with Chinese names and history. So I'm trying to make that introduction easier.

A quick word for those who have been following my work since the beginning. You will notice that the episodes from my first two podcasts in this effort — the Romance of the Three Kingdoms Podcast and the Water Margin Podcast — have all been imported into this podcast's feed. I did that so as to collect all my work in one place going forward, instead of creating a new podcast for every new novel I cover. So if you have already listened to those two previous podcasts, just go ahead and skip the first 300 or so episodes on this feed.

For those of you who are discovering my work for the first time, just know that I was figuring it out as I went along at the beginning. The quality of the shows got significantly better as time went on, so
